<p><b>Sancerre, André Dezat et Fils</b>  <i>Benchmark stuff-ripe &amp; broad, with delicate notes of pressed white flowers &amp; excellent fruit. Dry, crisp &amp; intense, long &amp; mineral.</i></p>			£38.95
